

**HAZEL GREEN REGULAR BOARD MEETING
APRIL 21, 2015**

Clerk Sally Bauer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Proof of publication: notices were posted at American Bank, Post Office, Village Hall, and all the Trustees were notified by delivering of the agenda.

DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS REPORT:

~ The Village is in the process of changing the 3-phase wiring to single phase wiring for Gile Chiropractic.

~ For Earth Day on April 22, Southwestern High School students will be doing projects at Rec Park – painting concession stand, picking up sticks, etc.

~ Five (5) underground services were installed last week.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

POSSIBILITY OF ALLOWING FOR A DRIVEWAY OFF OF MAIN ST FOR ST. FRANCIS DE SALES: Village Engineer, Keith Dalsing gave an overview of the Grant we received and the new intersection at North Main St and Hwy 80. The Village submitted plans to the DOT to make the intersection safer by making North Main Street perpendicular with Hwy 80. This will reduce semi traffic from coming onto Main Street, reduce the speed of vehicles coming onto Main Street and giving vehicles entering onto the highway a better look at the traffic they will be entering into.

By doing this, the DOT will not allow for St. Francis de Sales to have a driveway that comes out onto the highway for safety reasons. The DOT states the two (2) driveways the church has on 26th Street are adequate for the parcel.

For St. Francis de Sales to have a driveway onto Main Street, the driveway would have to be 50 feet from the right-of-way of an arterial street (Hwy 80) per 14.16(5)(b)3

(5) *HIGHWAY ACCESS. (a) Private Access Restricted. No direct private access shall be permitted to the existing or proposed rights of way of expressways nor to any controlled access arterial street without permission of the highway agency that has access control jurisdiction.*

(b) *Public or Private Access Prohibited. No direct public or private access shall be permitted to the existing or proposed right of way of the following;*

3. *Streets intersecting an arterial street within 50 feet of the intersection of the right of way lines.*

It is the recommendation of the Village Engineer to make North Main Street perpendicular to Hwy 80 as a safety improvement.

Fr. Ken Frisch understands that leaving the existing driveway where it is not an option but is wondering if there are other options available.

The DOT had recommended if St. Francis de Sales wanted a driveway on Main Street to have the driveway start on the south end of their property on Main Street and follow the hedge line north to the current parking lot. Representatives from the church did not like this idea because of the cost to install the driveway.

John Berning and Keith Dalsing will mark out on North Main Street where the 50 feet right-of-way would be to see if St. Francis de Sales would be interested in installing a driveway there.

Please note that the DOT does not make decisions on approving or denying permits about state roads in which municipalities are working in/on state right-of-ways until plans are approved by the municipality first.
