

**HAZEL GREEN LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING
MAY 19, 2015**

Chairperson Dale Leifker called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Proof of publication: notices were posted at American Bank, Post Office, Village Hall, and all the Trustees were notified by delivering of the agenda.

Trustees present: Sarah Saylor and Bill Wiegman.

Employees present: Sally Bauer and Sergeant Brandon Clark.

MARCH & APRIL POLICE REPORT: Sergeant Clark presented the committee with the March & April 2015 police reports. The committee did not have any questions, comments or concerns about the report.

CREATE AN ORDINANCE TO RESTRICT PARKING OF CERTAIN VEHICLES (BOATS, CAMPERS, ETC.) ON THE STREETS: Dale Leifker made the recommendation to adopt the following ordinance:

***Street parking.** No person owning or having control of any truck, trailer, truck power unit, tractor, bus or recreation vehicle in excess of 12,000 pounds licensed vehicle weight, or over 24 feet in length, or having an enclosed area of height of more than eight feet from the roadway, shall park the same upon any street, avenue or public right-of-way in the Village zoned residential or adjacent to residential areas. The provisions of this subsection shall not be deemed to prohibit the lawful parking of such equipment upon any street, avenue or public way in the Village for construction, building, landscaping or related purposes, or for the actual loading or unloading of goods, ware or merchandise; providing, however, the uses as described in this section shall be limited to the actual time consumed in such operations or while such operations continue.*

Boats, boat trailers, animal trailers, snowmobiles, snowmobile trailers, and other unmotorized trailers, or off-road motor vehicles shall not be parked upon any street, avenue, or public right-of-way.

***Removal.** Any vehicle unlawfully parked under Subsections A and B above, may be removed from the street by order of a law enforcement officer, pursuant to § 320-20, and the expense of so moving and storing such vehicle shall be paid by the operator or owner of said vehicle as a forfeiture in addition to the penalties hereafter prescribed.*

The Police Department may issue temporary permits for parking the above-mentioned vehicles not to exceed 48 hours.

Sarah Saylor seconded the recommendation. Roll call vote: Sarah Saylor-yes, Trustee Bill Wiegman-yes and Dale Leifker-yes. Motion carried 3-0.

Sarah Saylor made the motion to adjourn at 6:45 p.m. Dale Leifker seconded the motion. The committee agreed.
