**COMMUNICATIONS:**

**CLERK:** The clerk's conference is in August in Appleton. We are also looking at permit fees and what needs to be published and what needs to be posted.

**DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS REPORT, JOHN BERNING:**

**DISCUSSION OF ATTENDANCE OR APPEARANCE OF BOARD MEMBERS AT EMERGENCY EVENTS AND/OR POLICE MATTERS:** Chief Monahan explained to the board that they are not to show up at police scenes, whether it be a traffic stop, an EMS call, a fire, etc. they should not be there be asking questions. If they interfere with the job that emergency personal are performing, they can be charged with obstruction. Sergeant Clark also added that it is also in the public's best interest to not show up/drive by a scene for safety reasons as the public does not know whether a scene is secure.

When it was asked about board members getting the information, Clerk Sally Bauer explained to the board that they are only board members when they are at a meeting. They are not privy to any information about a scene that the police, EMS or fire may be called to.

**PUBLIC HEARING AT 7:30 P.M. TO REZONE A PORTION OF PARCEL 136-00395-0000 FROM A-1 AGRICULTURAL TO R-1 SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL:**

**REVIEW ORDINANCE 7.05(3C) - STREET PARKING:** This ordinance was reviewed by the board. The board is having the attorney make changes to the current ordinance to allow for trucks, trailers, campers, recreation vehicles to be parked on the street for up to 48 hours in any 7 day period, if over 48 hours, it is up to the person to contact the police department to issue a temporary permit to park on the street. The penalty will be a ticket and/or have it towed at the owner's expense or both. This will be reviewed again by the board.

President Dale Leifker made the motion to adjourn at 8:14 p.m. Trustee Dave Jegerlehner seconded the motion. The committee agreed.
