**ORDINANCE:** The board was informed that the ATV/UTV Committee recommended approving the ordinance as it was presented. Trustee John Tranel made the motion to approve the following ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO 2017-01

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*AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTION 7.10 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HAZEL GREEN, GRANT AND LAFAYETTE COUNTIES, WISCONSIN, RELATING TO ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE OPERATION AND ROUTE AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF*

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*THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF HAZEL GREEN, GRANT AND LAFAYETTE COUNTIES, WISCONSIN, DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:*

**Section I:** *Section 7.10 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Hazel Green is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:*

**“7.10 ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLES AND ROUTES**

(1) *PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish an all-terrain vehicle (“ATV”) and utility terrain vehicle (“UTV”) route in the Village of Hazel Green and regulate the operation of all-terrain and utility terrain vehicles in the Village.*

(2) *OPERATION AND EQUIPMENT OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLES.* Operation and equipment of ATVs and UTVs shall be subject to all provisions of Wis. Stat. sec. 23.33, as the same may be amended from time to time.

(3) *DESIGNATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTE.* The designated all-terrain vehicle and utility terrain vehicle route in the Village of Hazel Green shall be all streets designated by the Village Board by resolution from time to time which streets are properly signed.

(4) *CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTES.* In addition to the requirements of Wis. Stat. sec. 23.33, pursuant to Wis. Stat. sec. 23.33(8)(d), the following restrictions are placed on the use of ATVs and UTVs on the Village route:

(a) *The speed limit on the Village route is 10 mph.*

(b) *No person may possess on his or her person or in or on an ATV or UTV upon the Village route, any bottle or receptacle containing alcohol beverages if the bottle or receptacle has been opened, the seal has been broken or the contents of the bottle or receptacle have been partially removed or released.*

(c) *The Village of Hazel Green may close ATV/UTV routes due to road emergencies including but not limited to blizzards or flooding or other safety hazards.*

(d) *Village ATV/UTV routes shall be open each day between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m.*

(5) *ROUTE SIGNAGE.* Routes shall be marked with uniform all-terrain vehicle route signs in accordance with s. NR 64.12(7), Wisconsin Administrative Code. No person may interfere with sign or standard as provided under Wis. Stat. sec. 23.33(8)(f).

(6) *A copy of this ordinance shall be sent by the Village Clerk to the Hazel Green Police Department and the Department of Natural Resources, PO Box 7921 Madison, WI 53707.*

(7) *ENFORCEMENT.* The penalties under Wis. Stat. sec. 23.33(13)(a), as the same may be amended from time to time, are adopted by reference. This ordinance may be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

(8) *SEVERABILITY.* If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provision or application of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provision of this ordinance are severable.”

**Section II:** *This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and posting as required by law.*
